

Organisation of ILCA Annual Conference 2021 (the Virtual Conference).

International Liver Cancer Association (ILCA) will host its 15th Annual Conference in the format of a virtual conference on 2 – 5 September 2021 (the "Virtual Conference"). MCI Benelux S.A. ("MCI") will support ILCA as it is responsible for registration aspects of the Virtual Conference for participants. On registering for the event, participants (also referred to as "you") are entering an agreement with ILCA and MCI. By registering to the Virtual Conference, you are indicating your acceptance to the terms and conditions set out below.

Format and Conference Dates

Education and scientific content will be available in the following format:

• LIVE streaming: Thursday, 2nd, Friday, 3rd, Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th September beginning at 13:45 CET. All live broadcast content will be available for on-demand viewing 3 months after the conference.

Registration Fee

All participants must register for the Virtual Conference via the online registration system. Online registration will be open for the duration of the conference.

Registration Fee for Participants includes:

- Admission to all sessions
- Availability of all virtual conference content for "on-demand" viewing during 3 months after the event

*The following VAT rules are applicable:

VAT 21%

- Customer is a legal person registered in Belgium
- Customer is a natural person residing in Belgium
- Article 45 Council Directive 2006/112/EC: customer is a natural person residing in the EU;
- Article 45 Council Directive 2006/112/EC: customer is a natural person residing outside the EU.

VAT 0%

- Article 44 'Reverse Charge' Council Directive 2006/112/EC: customer is a legal person registered in the EU;
- Article 44 'Outside Scope' Council Directive 2006/112/EC: customer is a legal person registered outside the EU;

Methods of Payment

Payments can be made via credit card. Confirmation of your credit card payment, along with the registration confirmation, will be made available immediately after the payment, not only by sending an email but also by being notified by an on-screen message. Payment must be made before the stated deadline that applies to your application.

Please let us know in case you cannot process payments by credit card. In this case, we can process your payment via bank transfer. Please contact the organizers of the ILCA Virtual Conference at events@ilca-online.org for further details.

Payment via Credit Card

Visa, American Express or Mastercard are accepted for credit card payments, which can be made online during the registration process.

In case of rejected online credit/debit card payment, the delegate is recommended to log into the registration system and try to process the payment again. Should the trouble with the payment persist, the participant is advised to contact the credit/debit card issuer/bank first and check if online transactions are not disabled on the credit/debit card. Afterwards, the registration can be processed again.

Registration Cancellation & Refund Policy

All registration cancellation requests should be sent in writing to events@ilca-online.org.

The following cancellation fees will apply:

- Cancellations received up to 20 June: full refund minus a 45€ administrative fee (excluding applicable VAT)
- Cancellations received as of 21 June: no refund possible

All refunds are subject to prevailing exchange rates. Refunds will be made after the event in the same manner as the original payment was received. If bank charges apply, they will be deducted from the refunded amount.

Registration replacement requests should be sent in writing to events@ilca-online.org by 2 August 2021 and can be accommodated at no costs until the above mentioned date. As of 3 August 2021, registration replacement requests will not be accepted, and the cancellation policy will apply.

Invoice

The invoice will be provided to the participants only upon full payment. The invoice will be issued based on details supplied while registering (invoice details).

Modification and Cancellation of the Congress

The organizers of the Virtual Conference reserve the right to modify the Virtual Conference programme, which is published as an indication only.

In the event of cancellation of the Virtual Conference, at any time, as a result of any event of "force majeure" or for other reasons that are beyond the control of ILCA, the participant shall waive any claim for damages or compensation except the amount paid for registration after deduction of actual expenses incurred in connection with the Event and there shall be no future liability for either party.

Use of Materials

You agree not to reproduce, copy, or translate the Virtual Conference materials or create derivative works from them or modify them or in any way commercially exploit them without our prior written consent.

The participant acknowledges that he/she has no right to lodge damage claims against the organisers should the holding of the event be hindered or prevented by unexpected political or economic events or generally by force majeure, or should the non-appearance of speakers or other reasons necessitate programme changes. Any dispute resulting from the above terms and conditions will be subject to Belgian law, and by accepting these terms you are submitting yourself to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Belgium.
